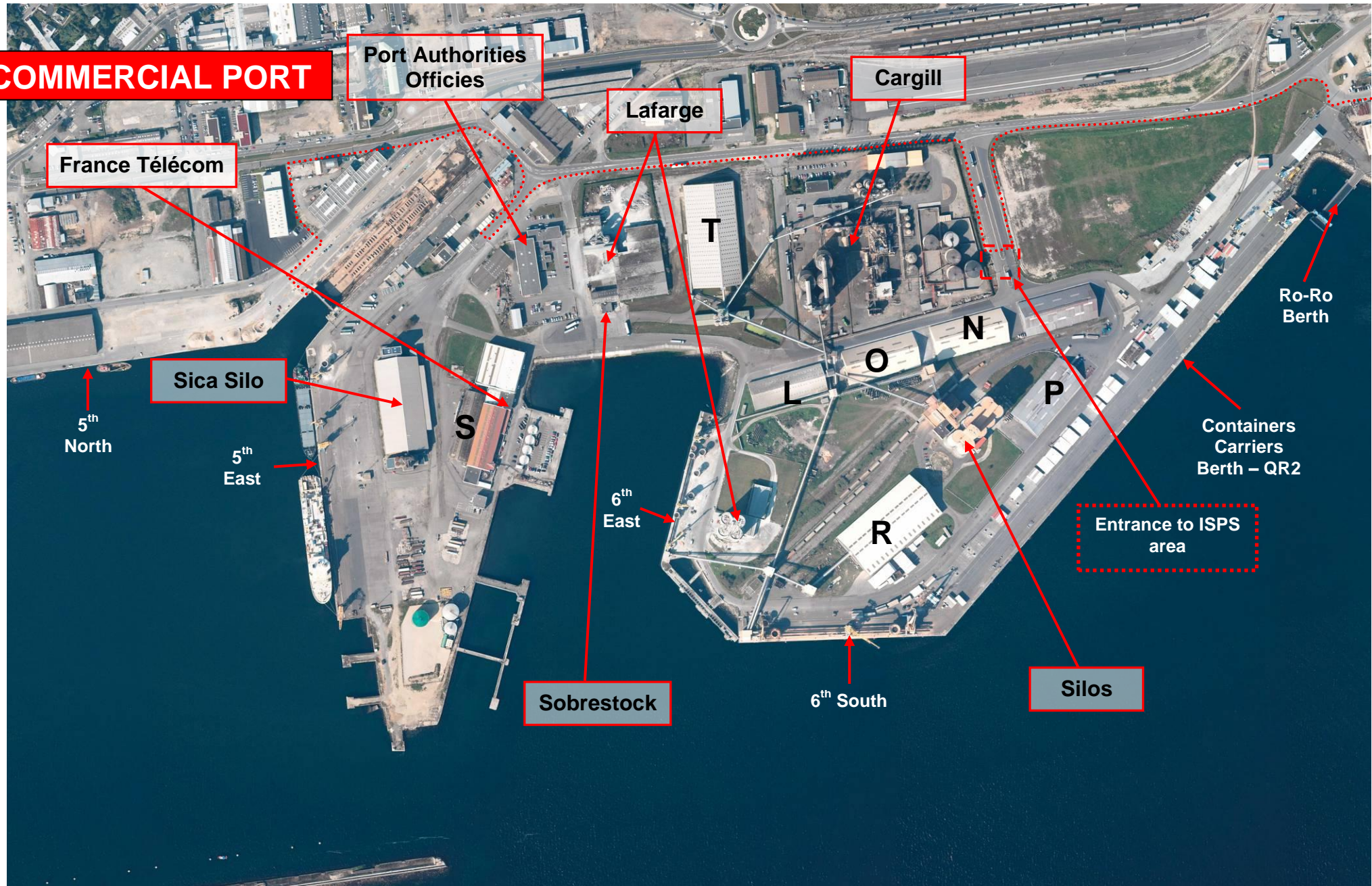

## Safety and security instructions in the Commercial Port area

### You are entering ISPS Commercial Port...

ISPS zone meets International Maritime Code requirements for Ships & Port Facilities Security.

Get full knowledge of rules and instructions through advertisement posted on checkpoint bungalow.

Port Police Officers enforce respect of rules.

Commercial Port's activities bring numerous risks, and your own intervention can cause danger and damage for other people.

# Quays and their surroundings

When on the Terminal, please remain vigilant at all times

The commercial port is a dangerous area. Please always follow the safety instructions to help ensure against injury to yourself or anybody else.



Speed max 30 km/h (18 m/h) unless otherwise instructed.



Beware of crane movements.  
Don't cross below loads!



No parking along crane rails, and close to gangways.  
Personal cars: no access to quays and dry-dock areas.



No drugs, no alcohol.



Container stacking machines have priority.



Smoking is not allowed in the buildings, handling installations and in loading / unloading areas.  
Dust explosion risks.

# Access

Restricted area to unauthorized persons

Access to offices, warehouses or any buildings is not permitted without specific access instructions from the signatory of your order form, recognised by Port Authorities.

- Location very specific of the event,
- Nature of the event and potential risks,
- Number of persons involved,
- Status of each victim,
- First steps taken and gestures made.

**Wait for instructions before interrupting communication.**

**Wait for rescuers at the checkpoint bungalow.**
